I cannot here enter further upon this very difficult word which is probably due to the confusion of several originally different words.2) It seems possible that the M. E., N. E. word is in part due to some groundform containing an original short a (cf. O. W. Scand. ras *swiftness, rapidity, quickness*, Swed. dial. ras *haste, quickness* (Rietz), O. W. Scand. rasa *to stumble* etc.); but for the settlement of this question many Teut. words need to be taken into consideration which...

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
